## THE SUN FROM MYTHS TO MODERN SCIENCE

How did we learn what we now know about the Sun and the Solar System? What are the latest discoveries in astronomy and are there riddles that have not yet been solved by science? We'll talk about the evolution of stars, the origins of the Sun and also its structure, the use of solar energy and energy efficiency. Astronomy here is interconnected with biology, medicine, geography, meteorology and history. There are fun experiments to carry out, too!



### PART 1

#### FROM MYTH TO KNOWLEDGE

Did you know that the Sun is a star, a gigantic hot ball around which our planet orbits? That is the source of heat and light, without which life on Earth is impossible. Of course you do! After all, you read it in your encyclopedia, heard it at school, seen it in movies.

But how could our distant ancestors have known about such a strange, yellow circle in the sky?

However, not knowing – that is, not being able to explain what is happening around them – is not the same as being afraid. Human instincts say: everything unknown is dangerous.

How did ancient people cope with unpleasant and dangerous ignorance? For example, did they answer the question: why does the sun rise?

Very simply! They made up myths. And in them...

...the sun and the moon move across the sky, why day changes from night, winter to summer, why eclipses occur...

...and the most important thing: getting educational answers from myths, people did not stop asking new questions. And so they moved from myths to knowledge. But the path was long and indirect...

#### GODS OF SPECIALIZATION

The ancient Greeks explained the movement of the Sun across the sky as follows: it is the god Helios (simply translated as "the Sun") who rides across the sky in a chariot pulled by a charioteer.

In this chariot are drawn by four horses. The fact that the sky is a solid crystal sphere, the "firmament", was clear to everyone in ancient times.

Curiously, the Greeks needed another god, Apollo, to explain the nature of light. It may seem strange to us, is there a sun without light, and light without sun? But this was not at all obvious to the ancients. In fact: in the morning it is light long before sunrise; the sun may be covered by clouds, mountains, but it will still be light. "The sun is a star that does not burn, it is a phenomenon," the ancients reasoned.


It was only in late Antiquity that Apollo and Helios were merged into one. This is how the sun was perceived as one god. Apparently, by then, the connection between light and the sun had become obvious to the Greeks and Romans.

But the Sun is not only a star that burns at night, not only brightens but also turns pink. (Physicists were only able to explain this in the 18th century, and we will learn about the pink Sun in the 30th century – so let's not laugh at the ancients). That is why in Greek mythology a separate goddess, Eos, was responsible for the dawn. The Romans called her Aurora.



As you can see, it was not easy to explain the nature of the Sun, or even just the morning light that dawned. Light and phenomena were obviously connected with it; all this had yet to be thought of.




## HOW PEOPLE INVENTED STARS

Ашшурбанапал, вероятно, был сама большая библиотека Древнего мира! Многие древние памятники неописанной глинянности дошли до наших дней только благодаря сделанным с них копиям. Так, например, шумерский эпос о великом Гильгамеше так бы и пропал в веках, если бы не Ашшурбанапал.








### I AM A PRINCESS!




